**Leave and Travel Concessions -**1. TITLE: **Isolated Centres** 

2. PURPOSE: These arrangements are in recognition of the need for officers and

their families to relieve the hardship and disabilities associated with

living in remote and isolated areas of the state.

3. LEGISLATIVE

PROVISION: Section 34(2) of the Public Service Act 1996.

4. APPLICATION: This directive applies to public service officers

It does not apply to -

employees engaged under sec' on 11. of the Public Service Act 1996;

employees engaged under activated 113 of the Public Service Act 1996.

5. STANDARD: The conditions and entitle ants prescribed in this Schedule apply.

6. EFFECTIVE

DATE: The directive is to release from 1 November 2001.

# **SCHEDULE A**

#### LEAVE AND TRAVEL CONCESSIONS

# **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

# **Eligibility**

These leave and travel concessions apply to public service officers (referred to as "officers" in this directive) who work at isolated centres (as defined in this directive).

#### **Entitlement**

The concessional arrangements described in this directive are available to officers every twelve months on the anniversary of the officer's date of commencement at the isolated centre.

The chief executive may grant the concessions at any time during each year of service at the isolated centre. This discretion is exercised by taking into account the particular circumstances of each case and the length of time the officer has spent at the isolated centre.

#### **Definitions**

"spouse" has the fame in aning as the Industrial Relations Act 1995.

# SCHEDULE B.

# Category

The conditions in this directive apply to officers of the public service including the teaching service.

# **Concessions**

# **Entitlement**

Leave may be granted to transact business, receive der a treatment, rulend specialist

ap ointments and undertake other personal atters that cannot be attended to in the centre.

Such leave may be taken either separately from or conjointly with recreation leave or long service leave and is subject to conditions as determined by the chief executive.

In the case of teachers this concession is not to be taken conjointly with vacation periods.

# TRAVEL CONCESSIONS

# **Entitlement**

Officers employed under section 8 of the *Public Service Act 1996* (including teachers); the spouse and any dependent children of the officer are eligible for concessions in accordance with this schedule.

# **Air Fares**

One return air fare each year from the centre of appointment to the designated major coastal centre (see Schedule of eligible centres) each year. This is non-cumulative.

In addition one return air fare from the centre of appointment to Brisbane or equivalent fares to any other centre within the state. This is non cumulative.

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Where the officer and spouse are both employed in eligible centres, as provided for in these arrangements, only one set of travel arrangements apply

There is no requirement for any members of the officer's family to utilise the concessional travel at the same time as the officer.

Any dependant child not residing at the isolated centre and attending boarding school or another educational institution is to be allowed concessional travel from the boarding school or educational institution to the selected destination and return provided that-

- the travel is taken at the same time the officer and/or the officer's family undertakes the concessional travel; and
- the cost does not exceed the travel costs that would have been incurred had the child been resident at the isolated centre.

Where appropriate air services are not available from the centre of appointment a motor vehicle allowance, similar to that payable to officers on transfer, is payable for the distance travelled for the forward and return journeys from the centre of appointment to the nearest air terminal.

# **Private Motor Vehicle**

Where an officer choose to use a price emotor vehicle instead of circle el the officer is entitled to -

- A motor veh. le allowa ce; and
- Over light accommudation and meals

for the distance traelled from the centre of appointment whice applicable destinations and return. This is on the same basis as that applicable to officers on transfer using their private motor vehicle (ministerial directive: Transfer and Appointment Expenses) subject to the total cost not exceeding the costs of air fares.

The payment of cash in lieu of air fare concessions (for the officer only) does not preclude other members of the officer's family possibly being eligible for concessions.

Applications for the cashing in of travel concessions are subject to such conditions as the chief executive determines. This may include constraints such as the timing and form of the application.

The application of provisions relating to visits by close family members is to be administered by chief executives with discretion to meet particular circumstances. Close family members generally refer to parents, children, brothers and sisters.

# Alternative transport

The chief executive may opprove travel expenses for an officer which the officer wants to use other form of the opport instead of air travel or provide. Approval is based on force the opens of incurred from the centre of appointment the applicable destination and refer provided that the cost donor not expeed the cost of air fares.

her, fares allowable in terms of this apportant and all payments relating to them is to be used on any special rate negotiated by the department with an approved carrier and should not exceed economy air fares rates where applicable.

# Cash payment instead of travel

Where an officer wants to cash in an entitlement to return air fares before any travel is undertaken, the chief executive may approve payment in lieu of travelling expenses not exceeding the amount of the air fare entitlement for the officer only.

However where the officer wants to transport close family members to the centre of appointment instead of outward travel the chief executive may permit the transfer of travel concessions applicable to the officer and the officer's spouse only.
